












A Message from the President of BC Minor Baseball Association

Coaches meeting will be held at Luxton Park on Wednesday July 23, 2025 at 7pm. Coaches from each team are required to attend.

Tournament information and Welcome packages

Tournament Information Packages with information for official score keepers, emergency plan, etc. will be provided to each team at the coaches meeting on Wednesday July 23. Each team will also receive the pre-ordered tournament t-shirts and complementary water and Gatorade.

Opening ceremony

The Opening ceremony is scheduled for Thursday July 24, 2025 at 6:30 pm at Luxton Park. parking may be limited. We strongly encourage teams and families to **carpool if possible**.

Batting Cages

Code of Conduct

Field Prep and Maintenance:

Field prep and takedown will be handled by tournament volunteers.

Amenities

Luxton Park: Concession is open with a full menu. Five minutes away, Westshore Mall offers grocery stores, fast food, and dining options.

Layritz: Concession will be limited and open air. Many stores and restaurants are within 5-10 minute drive.

Emergency services

All teams are required lo appoint a firstaid attendant to monitor player health and safety. The emergency services tent will provide access to further first aid supplies and a safe space for players to receive off field medical attention. Please note the host tent will not have a first aid attendant on site.

Hospital Location

Victoria General Hospital is located 15 minutes away from Luxton Park and 12 minutes away from Layritz Park.






